## Carnival

Bond Head has been confirmed for the Grade 8 graduation on Monday June 26. Grads to arrive at $5: 15 \mathrm{pm}$, Dinner will be at $5: 30 \mathrm{pm}$, Graduation Ceremony to commence 7:00pm, Reception from 8:00-9:00pm. The Dinner has been earmarked at 63 people -52 grads + staff, numbers can still be adjusted.
Bottle Drive: Raised \$1000 - Plan to have another Bottle Drive after Easter.
Costing: Room rental is $\$ 1000$, Dinner is $\$ 30$ per person $+18 \%$ gratuity + HST, Tea and Coffee station is $\$ 260+18 \%$ gratuity + HST, Punch Table is $\$ 260+18 \%$ gratuity + HST. If we pay for the graduation from the school account we will be refunded the HST.

Rides to The Club at Bond Head: Google form to ask if anyone needs a ride or can offer to give a ride.

Grade 8 Team still needs to submit the paperwork to register for the trip. A formal information package is to be presented to eh Principal for approval before the trip can be confirmed. Medeba Camp, West Guilford has been selected for the trip, as they offer fantastic sports/adventure programming. Aiming for the 17-19 May. Estimated cost is $\$ 220-250$ per person including busses to and from camp.
We would really like to do a Carnival again this year, June 8 has been selected as the date for the event, Principal Blakeley to request a permit. Last year the money made from the vendors went towards covering the cost of the inflatables. This year it has been suggested to consider more inflatables, stands as the line ups last year were quite long. However the school population is much smaller this year so perhaps the additions will not be necessary. Vendors being considered - Little Caesars Pizza, Holland Marsh Farmers, Abrisham Hallal, Zucca's Food truck, Ice cream. Discussion as to whether to have all food sales presales as was done last year.
